10-member team to market Kenya as conference destination

A 10-member task force has been formed to establish a Convention

Tourism Cabinet Secretary Najib Balala said the agency will market the country as a conference destination to increase tourist arrivals. It will be chaired

However, in the recent years, conferences have increased. Kenya is currently ranked among the top three conference destinations in Africa, Balala said.

its report within 30 days.

"We want to establish a bureau which will not only market Kenya international Convention Centre as the only convention centre, but also market Serena, Kempinski, Sarova and other facilities," the CS said.

He said the future of the tourism sector lies in convention tourism. Balala cited the just-ended Tokyo International Conference on African Development at the KICC. Some 47 head sof state and government attended the conference.

Kenya has hosted several high-level conferences since last year. They include TICAD VI, the UN Conference on Trade and Development, UN Environment Assembly and the Global Entrepreneurship Summit 2015, which was attended by US President Barack Obama.

Balala said the government wants to expand KICC, renovate the Bomas of Kenya and build a 10,000-capacity conference facility at the Coast. "We will build a new conference hall at the KICC and look at how best to build a modern
