THERE IS A DISTINCTLY ETHEREAL FEEL AT SOI, almost as if you are being transported back in time to a place where there was a lady violinist waiting for you in a corner to play you tinkling music as you ate, and a fan bearer to wave away heavy night air. It feels like a different time and a different place, which is an interesting feeling to have when you're smack dab in the middle of one of Nairobi's smaller business districts.

That ethereal touch is added to by the décor, candles that look like lotus flowers dot the centrepieces of tables; circular bamboo-like lamps add moody lighting to the inside of the restaurant, and outside, the tables look out into a dusky, trimmed garden. I was there when Chef Nishant was visiting from Dusit Devarana (New Delhi), and the experience was incomparable - not just because of the service, or the surroundings, but also because Chef Nishant made the tastiest beef short rib (slathered in young coconut) I have ever eaten in my life. Be sure to call and make a reservation first - we were lucky to get the last table, outside, as bookings are made days in advance.
